The Drive to Electrify Our Cars 2013

New fuel-economy standards are pushing automakers to make their conventional cars more fuel-efficient and aerodynamic. They're also turning to electrification to increase MPG, introducing new hybrids and beginning to offer plug-in hybrid and fully-electric cars. What are the obstacles to plug-in cars? Is it time for you to buy a plug-in car? How well do hybrid and plug-in cars reduce not only energy consumption but global warming and smog-forming air pollution?

John Kurmann of ReEnergizeKC (ReEnergizeKC.org) will begin the course with an overview of hybrid, plug-in hybrid, and battery-electric vehicle technologies. Then, Craig Volland, Air Quality Chair of the Kansas Sierra Club, will address the changes we need to make to our electricity grid and regulatory system to maximize the benefits of plug-in vehicles.
