Keynote Speaker — Bev Stobie

Bev grew up in St. Louis and now lives in Villa Ridge Missouri with her husband Bob, a retired educator, and their two Golden Retrievers, Henry and Josie. They have two grown children, a granddaughter that just turned 2 and another granddaughter on the way. Bev has worked for the past 34 years as a Registered Dental Hygienist. She became a Presbyterian 26 years ago when a Presbyterian co-worker decided to help her find a church home and spent a whole summer visiting various churches with her until she found the right one. Today she is a Ruling Elder at First Presbyterian Church of Union Missouri. She spent two years serving on the Presbytery of Giddings-Lovejoy Design Team, is currently a member of their Leadership Team and will be a commissioner at the upcoming General Assembly in Detroit.

Keynote Speaker — Kristy Childs

Kristy Childs is the founder and Executive Director of Veronica's Voice, a Kansas City-based organization dedicated to ending commercial sexual exploitation. In 2000, Kristy started Veronica's Voice, naming the organization in honor of a murdered sex-trafficked friend, Veronica Neverdusky. The organization's commitment to end commercial sexual exploitation is realized through a host of services for victims, as well as advocacy and legal work to target the demand. Kristy's vision and passion has been recognized with numerous awards recognizing her life work. Kristy has been involved in and recognized for significant legislative work, including garnering support for the 2005 Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act (TVPRA), as well as some of the key language used in this bill. She was invited to Washington, D.C. and was present when President Bush signed this bill on January 10, 2006. Kristy was invited by Kansas Attorney General Steve Six to be a member of the first Kansas Human Trafficking Advisory Board, which started in 2010. Kristy is a founding member of Sex Trafficking Survivors United (STSU) founded in October 2012.
