### **TIKAL ONE-DAY PACKAGE** via Antigua Tours

#### **US\$400.00 per person**

The Maya of Mesoamerica reached remarkable intellectual and artistic heights as far back as 3,114 BC when they began the calendar still in use today. They built huge temples, pyramids, stone monuments, and made major advances in mathematics, astronomy, and hieroglyphic scripts. The ancient civilization collapsed around 950 AD.

Tikal was an important center during the classic period, often called the soul of the earth. This magical place is guaranteed to be a great adventure. Across the park's 222 square miles over 3,000 separate buildings have been revealed: temples, shrines, ceremonial platforms, residences, ball courts, terraces, and plazas. The exuberant fauna and plant life are amazing.

Price includes: shuttles to/from airport; flights to/from Flores; shuttle to/from Flores to Tikal; park admission; professional guide services; lunch; 12% taxes; dinner; one additional night's lodging in Guatemala City; morning coffee & pastry; shuttle to airport for return flight to USA.

*Not included: beverages; guide tip; museum entrance*

Note: Climate at Tikal is hot and humid. Walking is involved. Choosing to go to the top of one or two of the temples will require some short bursts of vigorous climbing up steep steps, but it's very much worth the effort once you reach the top!
