

Powers for the 'New' Administrative Commission for KUPCK

1. Approve the following powers for the "New" Administrative Commission for the Korean United Presbyterian Church of Kansas:
 - a. Assume the duties of the Board of Directors for the Corporation known as the Korean United Presbyterian Church of Kansas and to elect from among the members of the board, that is, the members of the commission excluding any advisory members, officers of the corporation.
 - b. Terminate and dissolve the corporate body when all accounts are settled and it is deemed feasible and prudent.
 - c. Determine the use or disposal of the former church building at 4849 England St., Merriam, KS. If the property and furnishings are sold, the proceeds will be placed in a designated account for a period of no less than 24 months following the dissolution of the church (June 30, 2018) for use for a new ministry with the Kansas City metro Korean community.
 - d. Direct the use of funds designated for Kansas City metro Korean community for the commission's work.
 - e. Research and study the need for a PC(USA) planting a Korean Church in the Kansas City metro area.
 - f. Have the authority to consult with the former Administrative Commission, Commission on Ministry, Church Planting and Revitalization Division, Trustees, presbytery staff, former members of KUPCK, and any other consultants as needed.
 - g. Report regularly to the presbytery regarding their work.
